

Detailed Steps:

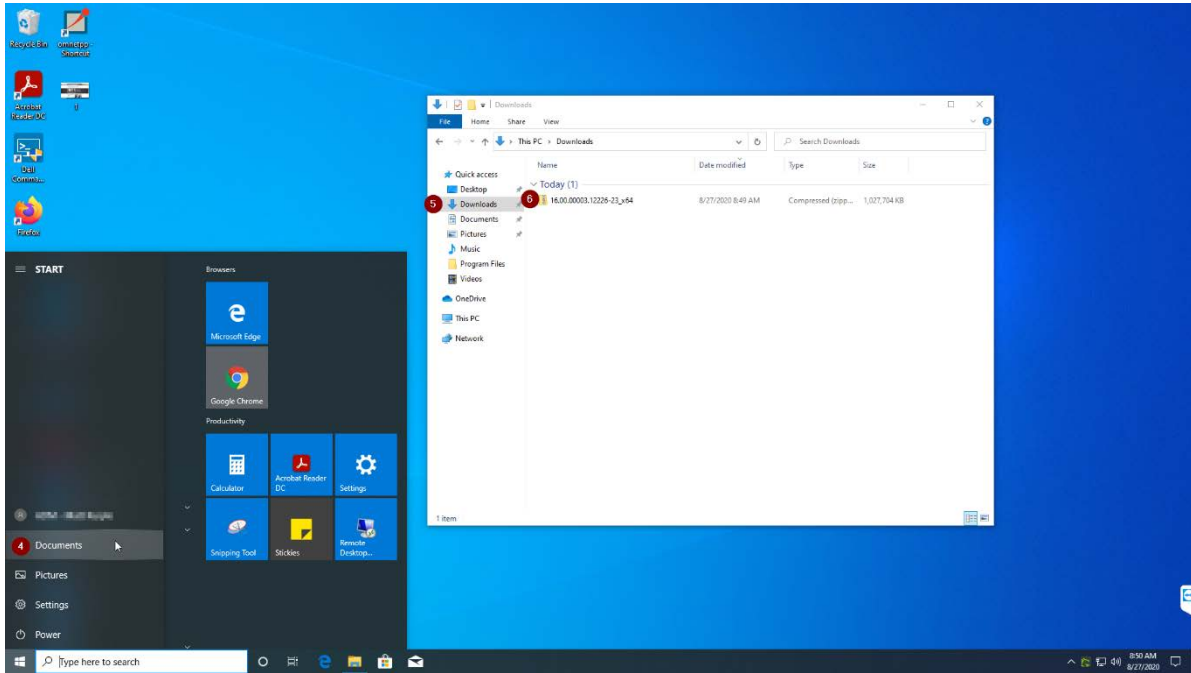
1. Open a web browser and go to <https://www.arenasimulation.com/academic/students>
2. Click "Download Arena for Students" in the center of the webpage.

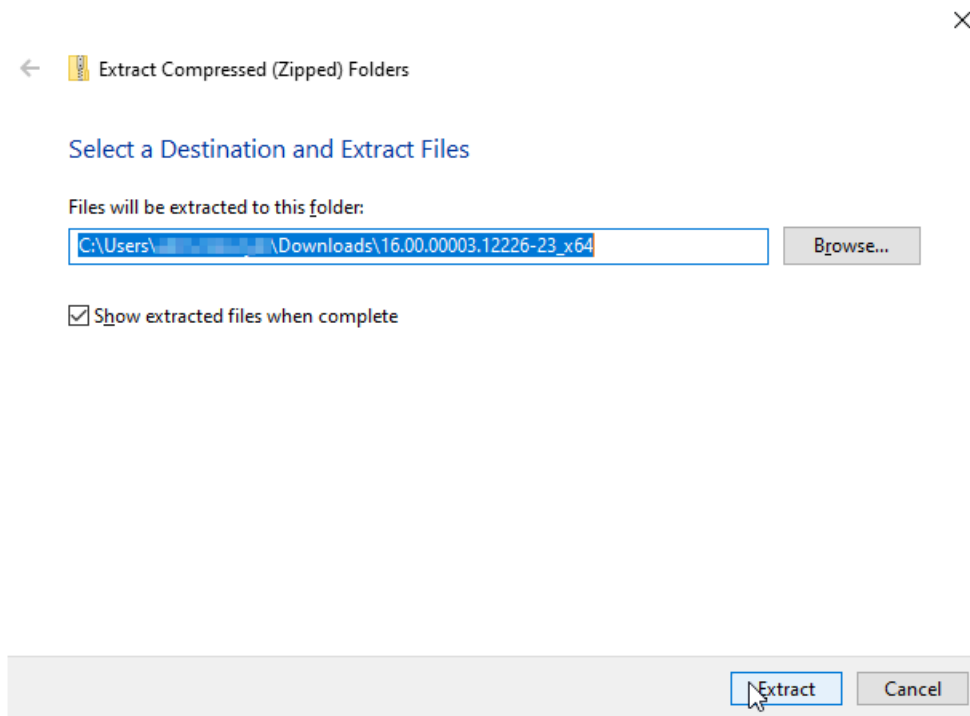

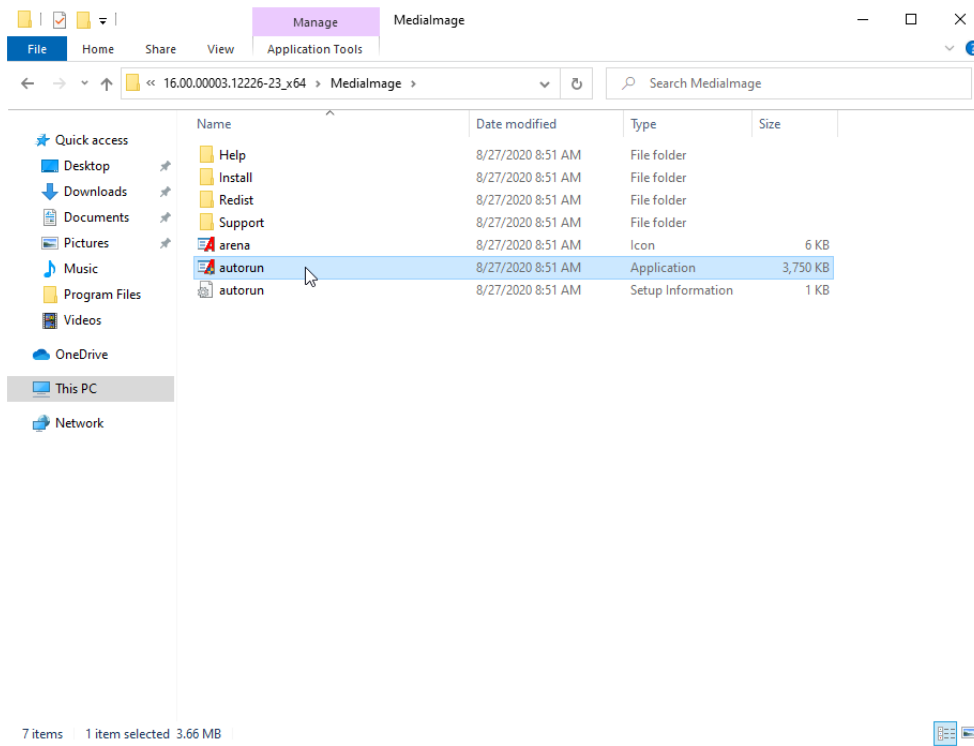
- After the download finishes, navigate to your "Downloads" Folder, by clicking "Start" and the clicking "Documents"

- Right click on "16.00.00003.12226-23_x64" and select "Extract All"



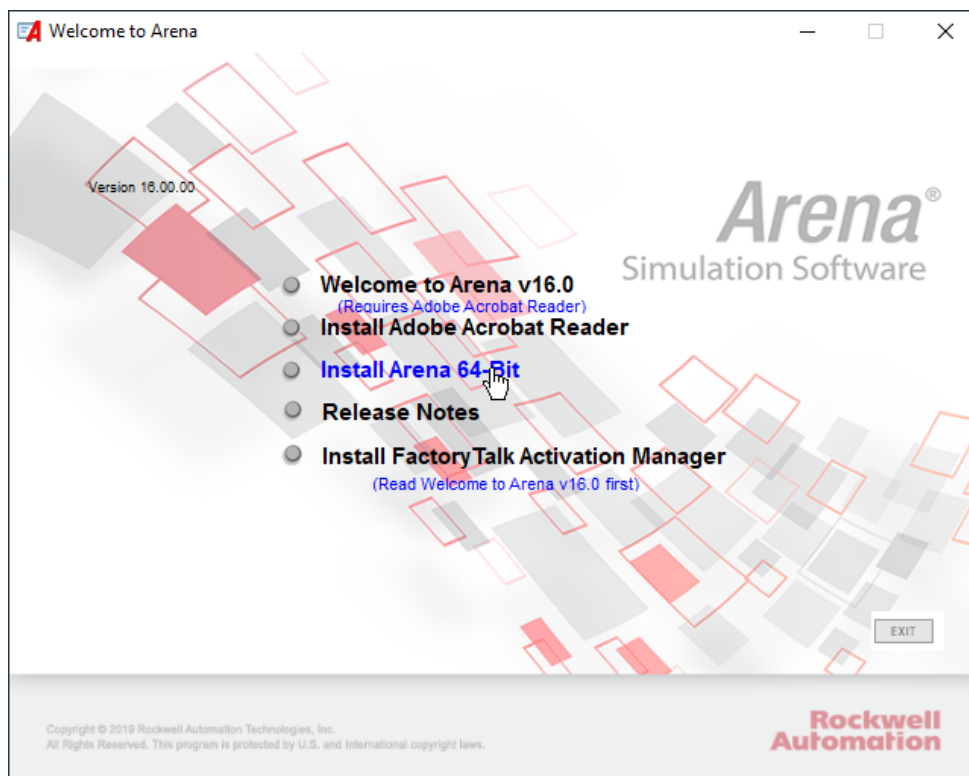
- You will be greeted by the extraction screen. Click "Extract" to continue.



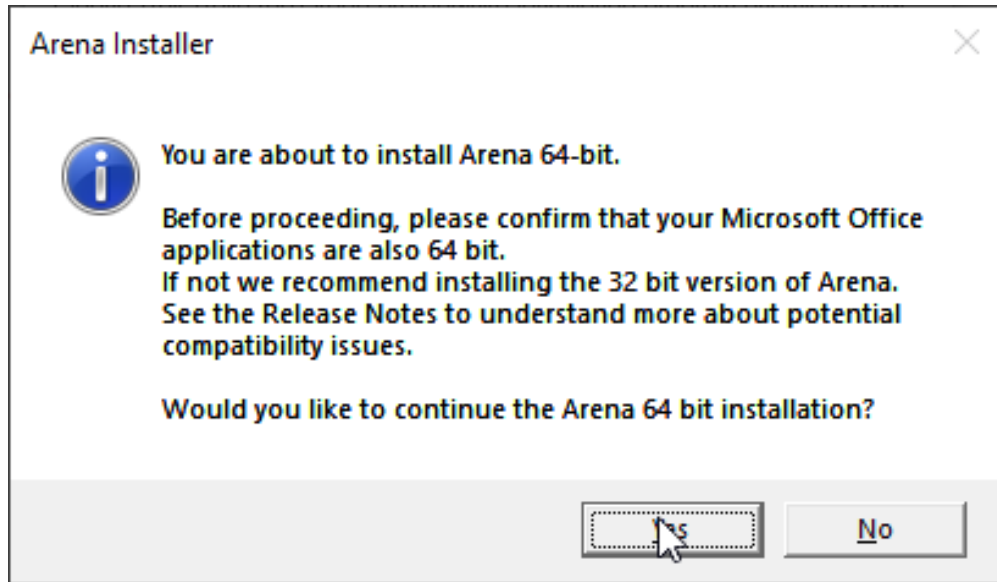
8. After extraction is complete, navigate to the “Medialmage” folder and click on “autorun” to start the Rockwell Arena Launcher.



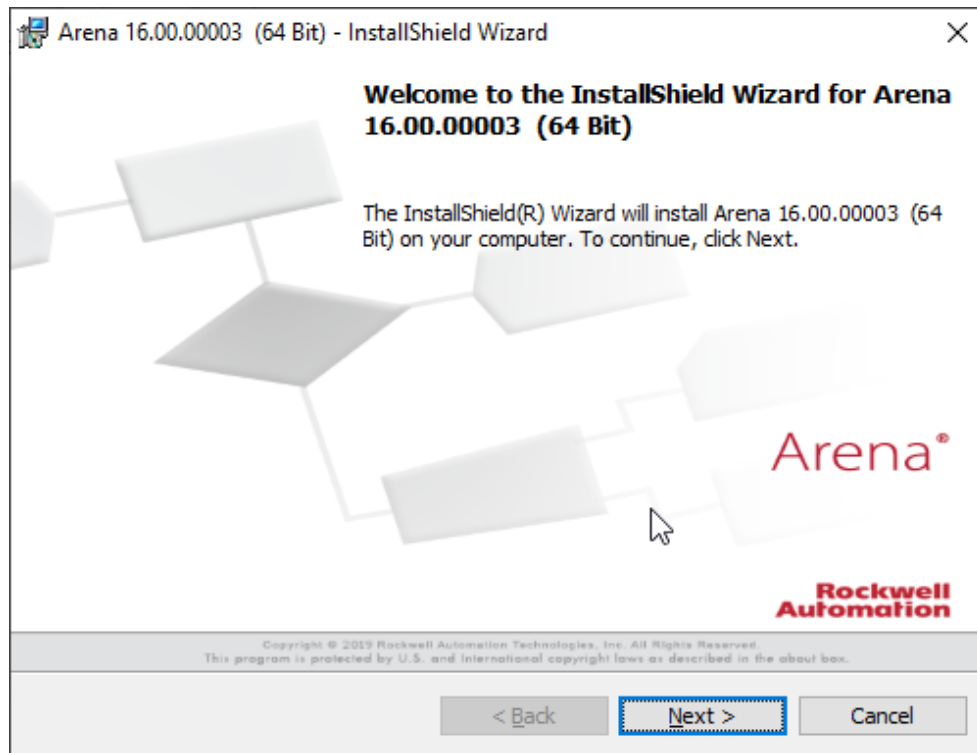
9. Click “Install Arena 64-bit” to start your installation.



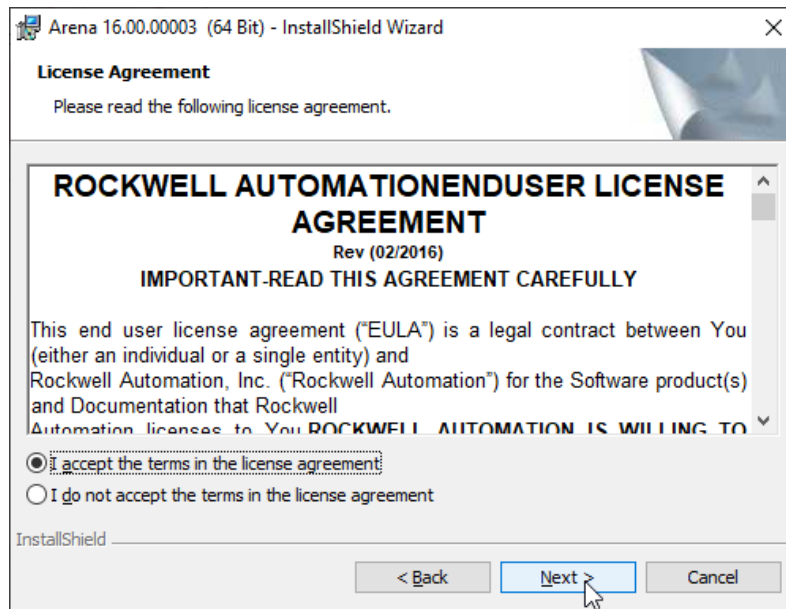
10. You will be prompted with a message regarding your Microsoft Office installation. Confirm the warning, Click “Yes” to continue.



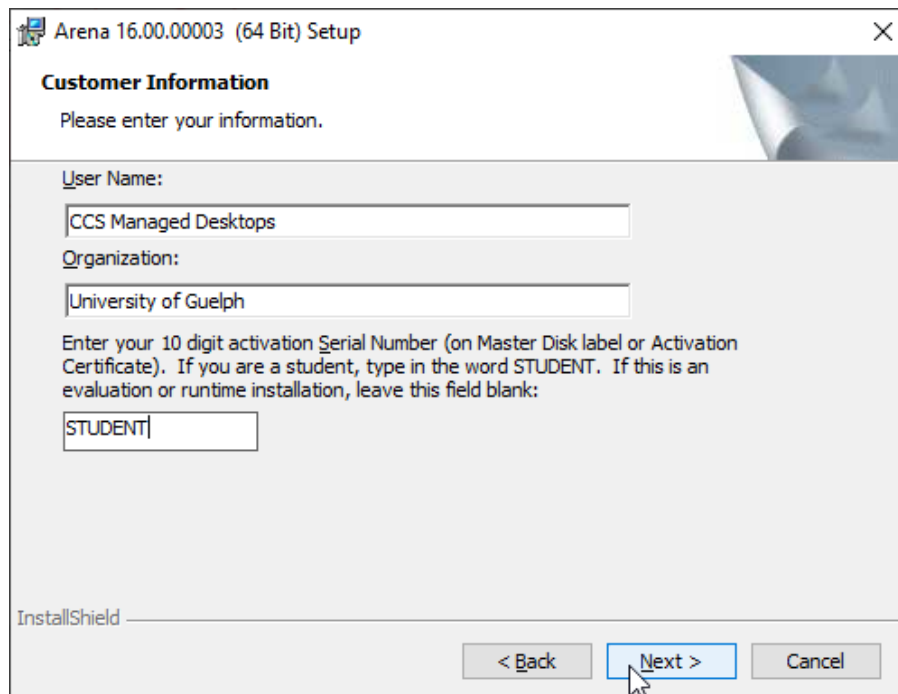
11. You will be greeted by the welcome screen, Click “Next”



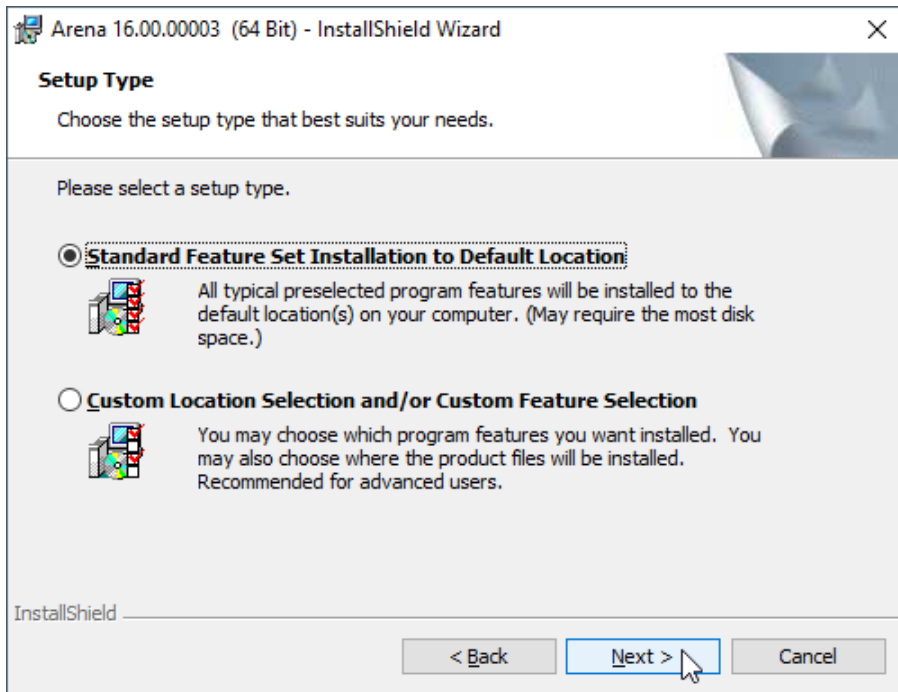
12. You will then be prompted with the “License Agreement” page, read the agreement and select “I accept the terms in the license agreement” and then click “Next” to continue



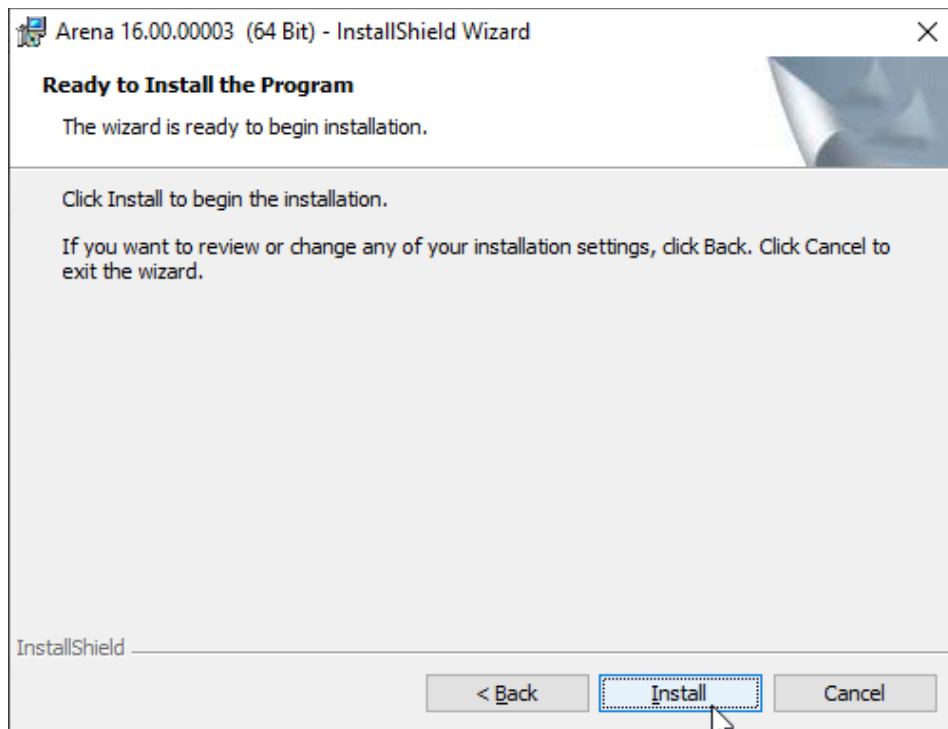
13. You will then be prompted with a “Customer Information” screen. Enter your information here, in the last field enter “STUDENT” then click “Next” to continue
